Good afternoon,

The first Biloxi court appearance went very well and was fairly slow. Anyone that attended with their citation was informed that it had been dismissed, and that insurance is required on their vehicle if they were wanting to avoid another ticket. Tracy and I spoke and bantered with court staff, and she was kind enough to bring the donuts for today.

We spoke with Chief Miller, as well. He is perfectly fine with a drop box for payments and has given us instructions for how he would prefer the instillation. I was also able to speak with Lieutenant Steve Kelly, who is more involved with the process on the ground level. He has been given my personal email and I informed him to contact me if he was ever in need of information or assistance. We had also come to the consensus that Biloxi court will now be 10am-1pm, so that the courthouse can conduct its early business for Offender Review, without us getting in the way of their foot traffic.

There is now a mailbox for returned mail, and the court staff have all been briefed on where to direct question regarding the program. Lieutenant Kelly has also shown me an email from the Police Precinct that shows their Major has informed all of the officers about the existence and legitimacy of the company. He has also suggested that we do another press release to give the public another chance to know about the company operating in the city.

The Chief and Lieutenant seemed excited for the future citations and eager to see how the company will continue to impact the city's uninsured driver rates.
