Mississippi Litigation Accountability Act Notice Letter

Mr. Rosenberg:

The City of Ocean Springs recently received the above referenced Open Meetings Complaint made by you.

Please accept this correspondence as a formal request the above styled complaint be immediately dismissed. This request is being made pursuant to the *Mississippi Litigation Accountability Act, Miss. Code Ann. § 11-55-1 et. seq.* because the allegations made and requests for relief are without substantial justification.

The allegations in the complaint are groundless in law because the Commission does not possess jurisdiction to evaluate the validity of any action taken by a public body. In this matter, minutes from the Recess Meeting of May 17, 2022 for the Mayor and Board of Aldermen undisputably exist as they were attached to your complaint as "Exhibit B". The allegations of the complaint generally ask the Commission to decide whether actions taken by the Board at that time are legally valid and/or that the Commission order the City of Ocean Springs to alter minutes from May 2022. The Commission lacks jurisdiction to do so.

On behalf of the City of Ocean Springs, I respectfully request this complaint be dismissed to avoid the expenditure of additional time and expense.

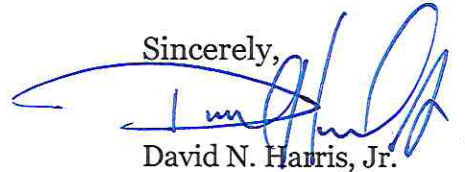
